Mladez English Camp (grade 7- university)

God never ceases to amaze us. We have had contacts with 20-30 young people at our Mladez English Camp; even some first contacts were with some parents.

A Mladez English Camp highlight was having an American team here with the youth! Our survey at the end of camp was positive and encouraging. Because of the American's team presence, we were able to include our core group (young leaders) onto various teams and into different classes. This allowed Christian young leaders to connect better with all the campers. Games and activities were enjoyed and the Gospel was presented in a variety of ways. The topic of our staff prayers was for God's truth to be first and foremost as our purpose.

We had a handful of new students from the schools who were hearing the Gospel for the first time. One of the young men who has been to 7 other English camps said, "This is the best English camp I have ever been to".

These young gentlemen watched the American staff very closely. They asked Bill, "Is every staff person here a Christian?" Bill said, "yes". The next day the students talked to 3 other staff people to verify that they were Christians and asked some of their testimony. It was thought provoking for them to see such love, kindness, and overall joy each of the team members had. These young gentlemen have not regularly attended the church youth group. Therefore, Bill and Luky (adult mladez leader) have been trying alternative meetings; pizza lunches and hikes. Dorost/Kormidlo Camp (grade 1- grade 7)

At our younger Dorost Camp, we connected with 20-25 young people; including new contacts again from the schools; some having never contemplated a God who loves them. Anna and Ella connected with us from the school across from our home. They came to the Dorost Camp for the first time. In the beginning all the talk about the Gospel was a little strange to them. They asked one of the leaders, "Why are all the songs about God/Jesus?" Talk about an opportunity! By the end of the week these two girls were dancing and singing around the fire their new favorite song of God's Love. AND they have connected with the church's Dorost Club and have been coming to Eileen's new once a month Saturday group for these young girls.



Public School Day Camps (grade 3- grade 9)

In the two sessions of public school day camps, we had 40 children enrolled. Again, we had wonderful support from some of the church youth as leaders. We are seeing growth in the generation by stepping forward to serve others outside of the church. Some of these contacts have led to openness and further follow up.
